YOUTH TOUR REQUIREMENTS:

1. This opportunity is only available for students whose parent/legal guardians receive electricity from Cooperative Light & Power (CLP). The Electric Cooperative Youth Tour is a benefit of co-op membership.
2. Student must be a high school sophomore or junior during the 2022-2023 school year.
3. Student must be available to participate in the dates and full schedule of the Electric Cooperative Youth Tour in Washington, D.C. which is June 13-18, 2023.
4. Student must be able to ride in a vehicle or bus for up to 12 hours (with breaks) in a single day.
5. Student must be able to fly in an airplane and provide a valid Minnesota driver's license or Minnesota state-issued ID card.
6. Student must agree to be photographed while on the Youth Tour, and must grant permission for cooperative use in publications, social media, websites, media, etc.
7. Student may be invited to attend a CLP Board Meeting and/or CLP Annual Meeting to recap their Youth Tour experience and gained knowledge of electric cooperatives.

I understand that if I am selected: If an unforeseen situation should occur, and I am not able to fulfill my obligation to attend, I must notify CLP prior to March 31, 2023 so that an alternate may be considered.
